Board Business

The Board held its quarterly meeting at the beginning of September.

Exploitation Work

At the meeting there was a presentation by Dr Peter Unwin from the University of Worcester, who shared findings from Adult Exploitation research they undertook on behalf of the WSAB

This research looked at the accessibility of services for people who had been exploited and made several recommendations.

These recommendations will be taken forward by a multiagency group which has been established and includes representative from the Police, Health, Adults Social Care and the District Councils.

The WSAB, Public Health and the South Worcestershire Community Safety Partnership have supported this work by funding a twoyear Exploitation Coordinator post.
